

# OUR PROCESS




## Step 1

Order your recycling box at [atire.ie](https://www.atire.ie)

## Step 2

Fill your box once your garments reach the end of their life.



## Step 3

Once your box is filled, please complete the returns form and arrange delivery to **Atire**.

## Step 4

We offer a fully sustainable solution, recycling 100% of the materials.



## Step 5

Atire will provide you with a recycling certificate upon completion.

# DO'S DEMO DONT'S



- Clean clothing is accepted.
- Fill the box as much as possible.
- Order one of our SafetyCare recycling boxes. Recycling will only be processed if it arrives in our SafetyCare recycling boxes.
- Weigh your box
- Complete the relevant returns paperwork/link attached

- Do not overfill the boxes. Any boxes that have split run the risk of becoming contaminated and SafetyCare reserve the right to return or not process these garments for recycling.
- Mix dirty or contaminated products with clean textiles.
- Forget to add your returns form to your recycling box before it's collected!
- Footwear cannot be recycled.

## ITEMS THAT YOU CAN RECYCLE:

- Garments (clean) hi-vis and non hi-vis
- Gloves (clean)

# SECURE RECYCLING PROCESS

- Branded Goods – These require shredding. Depending on quality (is it soiled) this material can then be used as stuffing for pillows, cushions, and even furniture.
- Non Branded Goods – 1st preference is ReWear (reuse), however again this will depend on quality and can be used as stuffing for pillows, cushions, and even furniture. Other uses for certain materials can include cleaning cloths.
- Plastics / Paper & Cardboard - All materials are 100% recycled.
